- The said school or organization will pay the said official the amount stated above for services provided, that the obligation of the school ceases if and when the official ceases to be a licensed official or if the contest is cancelled because of circumstances deemed acceptable by the IHSA Board of Directors.
- If a contract is made during a given school term for a contest to be played during the next school term and if, in the meantime, there is a change in the school principalship, the contract is valid only if and when the incoming principal has been notified of the existing contract and has sanctioned it or has failed to inform the official of cancellation within one week after the notification.
- If either party hereto fails to fulfill the obligation of any part of the contract, that party shall pay to the other party a sum equal to the contracted gross fee less mileage allowances as damages, the remainder of the contract shall not be binding, and the breach of contract shall be reported to the Association.
- Services provided by the Official are as an independent contractor and not an employee of the Illinois High School Association or the School, or Organization.
- The official assumes all liability for injury to him/herself and waives any claim for any injury, loss or damage against the IHSA which may be sustained by the official during any game, contest or activity.
- It is understood that the services of the official are provided as an independent contract and that no medical insurance, workers compensation, unemployment insurance or other benefit is accorded to the official by this contract.
- This contract becomes invalid if not signed by an authorized agent and returned by the Official on or before _____, 19_____.
