A school failing to participate for a championship in a sport after declaring for the sport shall forfeit the privilege for its students to participate in other conference, district, regional or state events until the penalty fee of \$25.00 per sport has been paid to the AAA office.

The AAA Executive Director shall have the authority to suspend the fine if, in his opinion the school's failure to comply was unavoidable. An administrator must submit a written request stating the extenuating circumstance.

Schools starting or dropping football or basketball programs shall notify the AAA office and the schools of the conference within ten (10) days after such decisions are made. Schools shall only be admitted to a conference, district or region in team sports at the beginning of a classification cycle.
