# Thursday, January 12, 2006 AAA Board of Directors Meeting Resumed

The Board of Directors of the Arkansas Activities Association met on Thursday, January 12, 2006, at the AAA Building at 9:00 a.m. with President Dr. Mike McSpadden, Alma, presiding. All board members were present. All AAA staff members were present as well. Mike Simmons, ADE liaison, Mark Benton representing the Arkansas Association of Nonpublic School Administrators, and Buzz Bolding, AHSAAA liaison, were also in attendance.

**MINUTES** – The minutes of the board meeting of October 20, 2006 were unanimously approved as presented. (Motion: Hughes/Foshee, 19-0)

**FINANCIAL REPORT** – Belle Summers reported that all football gate receipts had been received and all expenses are in, concluding a successful football season, aided by good team support and good weather. The board unanimously accepted the financial report. (Motion: Sample/Smith, 19-0)

**FOOTBALL PLAYOFFS -** Lance Taylor gave a report on the football playoffs and a review of the finals at War Memorial Stadium the first two weekends in December. Congratulations were extended to two board members whose schools participated in the football finals.

**SPRING SPORTS CONFERENCES** – The board unanimously approved all tentative conference assignments for bowling, soccer, track, baseball and softball. All spring sports conferences are based on basketball conference membership except Class AAA track, which is based on football conferences, as approved in 2002-03 and shown on the track page of the AAA web site. **BASKETBALL REGIONAL AND STATE TOURNAMENTS** –The board unanimously approved the regional and state tournament brackets and schedules, including the basketball finals at Alltel Arena in North Little Rock on March 10 and 11. # STATE BASKETBALL FINALS SCHEDULE

**SPRING SURVEY** – Lance Taylor reported that he is compiling questions for the Spring Survey to be discussed at the Activity District meetings. He encouraged the board to submit any additional items that they wish to be added.

**CORPORATE SPONSOR UPDATE** –Wadie Moore reviewed and updated information on the status of AAA corporate sponsorships and announced a two-year renewal with State Farm Insurance as well a renegotiated and extended contract with Wilson in their sponsorship role. Continuing sponsorships include Gatorade, Tyson, Greystone, Davis/Pack Associates, Athletic World Advertising, American Business, Inc., Wal-Mart, Russell Athletic, Ihigh.com, Arkansas Athletic Trainers Association, Stone Links, Alert Services, Lindsey and Associates, Regions Bank, Hot Springs Convention Center, Brown's Graduation Supplies and Kessler's. SBC/AT&T recently signed on as a sponsor of the state football finals and state basketball finals. Negotiations are in progress with First Security.

**VOLLEYBALL** – The board unanimously approved tabling all volleyball recommendations until the next meeting. ((Motion: Foshee/Tolbert, 19-0)

**PENALTY/FINE FOR NOT REPORTING FOOTBALL AND BASKETBALL SCHEDULES** – The board unanimously approved that a \$50 penalty/fine be assessed for each sport for which schools fail to report their football and/or basketball schedule by June 1 for the upcoming school year. For later changes or filling of open dates, updates will be accepted when these are known. The schedule brochure will be printed during the summer so as not to delay the printing of the AAA directory. (Motion: Diggs/Foshee, 19-0)

**UCA-AAA PARTNERSHIP** – Jim Lord, representing Varsity Spirit, Inc. addressed the board about formalizing and extending the partnership between the AAA and Universal Cheerleaders Association. The board unanimously approved the signing of a formal partnership agreement. (Motion: Hughes/Hogan, 19-0)

**PERSONNEL** – Following an Executive Session the board extended the contract of the Associate and Assistant Directors for an additional year through June 2008, and the contract of the Executive Director-elect through June 2009. (Motion: Berry/ Hughes, 19-0)

Upon the recommendation of the Executive Director-elect, the board approved the change in employment status of Annette Savage to become an Assistant Executive Director, effective July 1, 2006. (Motion: Sample/Smith, 19-0)

**NEXT MEETING -** The board unanimously approved a called meeting to be held prior to the next regular meeting to consider classification proposals regarding qualifying for and conducting championships and for considering the tabled volleyball recommendations. (Motion: Hughes/Diggs, 19-0)
