The winning pair from the Butler will join the winning team from the Playoff of pairs 2 through 5 to form the Australian International Youth Team to play in the World Championships in Beijing in early October 2008, with airfare and other costs paid by the ABF. Participants in the Butler must be born on or after 1 January 1982. The 2008 Australian U21 and U28 teams will be selected after the Youth Week is completed.

There will not be an international youth challenge match between Australia and New Zealand on Saturday January 19.

If you decide to stay for the week after Youth Week, the Australian National Open Championships have a 50% discount for full-time students in events which are part of the Summer Festival of Bridge.

Gold Master Points will be awarded at the appropriate ABF scale for the youth events.

Prizes and trophies in both the pairs and the teams will be awarded. Plenty of bridge book prizes are awarded including Handicap Prizes and Encouragement Prizes.

The atmosphere is friendly and players enjoy their time at the table and away from it. This event should be attractive to young players regardless of skill level and experience. Additional staff have been added in 2008, to enhance the experience.
