Nationally acclaimed Chess Author and Senior National Chess Master, Robert M. Snyder (International Rating: 2405) has agreed to conduct a Chess Camp in Bakersfield, California on June 5 and June 6, 2004.

Mr. Snyder is the author of 2 of the best selling chess books in the country: Chess for Juniors and Unbeatable Chess Lessons for Juniors. Mr. Snyder is also one of the top chess trainers in the U.S. His students have won First Place 35 times (The National Record) as individuals in championship sections at the National Scholastic Chess Championships.

Students will receive 5 hours of Chess Instruction per day (10 hours in total for 2 days). Cost is \$90 for 2 days and \$55 for one day. \$10 discount for 2 days and \$5 discount for one day if registration received by April 1, 2004.

The camp is intended for beginning and intermediate level chess players with ratings up to 1400 from ages 7 to 17. It is limited to a total of 32 students on a first come first serve basis.
