Blackman and Tjong Tjin Joe Sagicor 2008 Champs

Justin Blackman of Queens College and Calvin Tjong Tjin Joe of Surinam are 2008 Sagicor Open Junior Champions.

Blackman, needing only a draw in his last round match against Barbados Under-20 Champion Wendell Meusa, kept the Barbados Under-20 Champion at bay to force a draw and guarantee his first Sagicor Title.

Top Seed and three time Sagicor winner, Martyn Del Castilho of The Lodge School beat Stewart James of Jamaica to end tied on 6 points with Blackman and take 2nd position by virtue of the poorer tie-break score.

Meusa, on 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ points, completes the clean sweep of the top positions for Barbados by capturing 3^{rd} place.

Trinidad & Tobago Under-18 Champion Esan Wiltshire drew with Alex Jackman of Lester Vaughn to end as the highest placed overseas participant on 4th with 5 points.

Craig Clermond of UWI scored an upset win over Jamaica Junior Champion Damion Davy to also end on 5 points and take 5th position on the tie break. Jackman, who also has 5 points, takes 6th place.

Like Blackman in the Open Section, Calvin Tjong Tjin Joe of Surinam drew his final match with Damar Austin of St. Jude's Primary to win the Under-12 Section with 6 points.

Omari Teka of Grenada beat Rashaun Holland Christ Church Boys to end on 6 points with Tjong Tjoin Joe but finish 2nd as a result of the weaker tie break score.

Damar Austin took 3rd position with 5 ½ points.
